

Dr. Ing. Stephan Polomsky

Born in 1960, Dr. Polomsky studied Engineering, Ocean - and Offshore Technologies at the Universities of Aachen and Hamburg. He graduated in 1987, conducted various R&D projects in the area of Ocean Engineering and Underwater Technology and received his doctor degree in 1991.

He joined Transocean Shipmanagement of DAL/ John T. Essberger in 1991 responsible for all newbuildings. In 1993 he became Deputy Managing Director and Fleet Manager for the cement carrier fleet.

From 1996 as the Managing Director of Transocean Shipmanagement he was responsible for all newbuilding and shipmanagement aspects for a fleet of abt. 70 vessels including highly sophisticated, stainless steel Chemical Tankers, Product Carriers, ice classed Aframax Tankers, VLCCs/ ULCCs, Bulker Carriers of different sizes, Log Carriers and Container Vessels.

He consulted various oil companies and cement manufactures in the area of commodity transportation and distribution, including newbuilding projects for cement carriers, container vessels, chemical carrier and other tankers.

In 2007 Dr. Polomsky joined Reederei Claus-Peter Offen, a major owner in the container shipping industry and is since then responsible as Managing Director for the development of the newly established company Claus-Peter Offen Tankschiffreederei, **OFFEN TANKERS**, the construction, delivery and operation of 8 x 36.000 dwt Product Tankers, 8 x 52.000 dwt Product Tankers and for **OFFEN BULKERS** for 4 Cape-size Bulk Carriers.

In 2014 and 2015 **OFFEN TANKERS** took over the management of 10 Chemical and Product Tankers for Scorpio Tankers and during 2015 and 2016 **OFFEN BULKERS** will take over the management for 8 Cape Size Bulkers for Scorpio Bulkers.

Dr. Polomsky is a member of the Executive Committee of INTERTANKO, the independent tanker owner organisation. Since 2015 he is also the chairman of the INTERTANKO European panel. He also serves since more than 20 years in the Technical committee.

He is also a member of the advisory committees of classification societies DnV GL and Lloyd's Register and chaired the Environmental committee of Germanischer Lloyd for a number of years.

Throughout his career Dr. Polomsky published articles in various shipping magazines and held presentations on various conferences.
